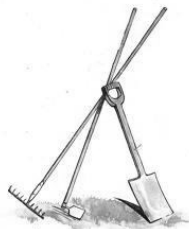

#### A Retreat with Benedict and Bernard: Seek God Alone – Together by Linus Mundy

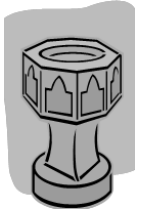


Many of us consider from time to time making a retreat. Something within us expresses the need for a time away from the day-to-day in which to reflect on the state of our lives and of our future. Many of us also find that the demands of family and work life stand in the way of making that time away a reality. This little book presents us with an alternative to the often inaccessible time away. It provides us with a structure that is both disciplined and flexible.

Divided into seven sessions or days (they could be weeks or any other interval), this book is designed around the theme “seeking God alone – together”. The primary resources used are the thought of two of the greatest saints of the Catholic Church, St. Benedict of Nursia (founder the Benedictine order) and St. Bernard of Clairvaux (an early abbot of the Cistercian order). Both men are renown for their practical wisdom and it is on display here as well. Each “day” contains a brief reflection on a theme (day six is called “Keeping it Simple”) using the thought of one our ‘retreat directors’. Day six, for example, focuses on St. Benedict’s ladder of humility. Following that are some questions for reflection and a closing prayer. This book is suitable for individuals or for groups that regularly meet and who could take one ‘day’ per meeting. It is quite inexpensive since used copies are readily available on the internet.
