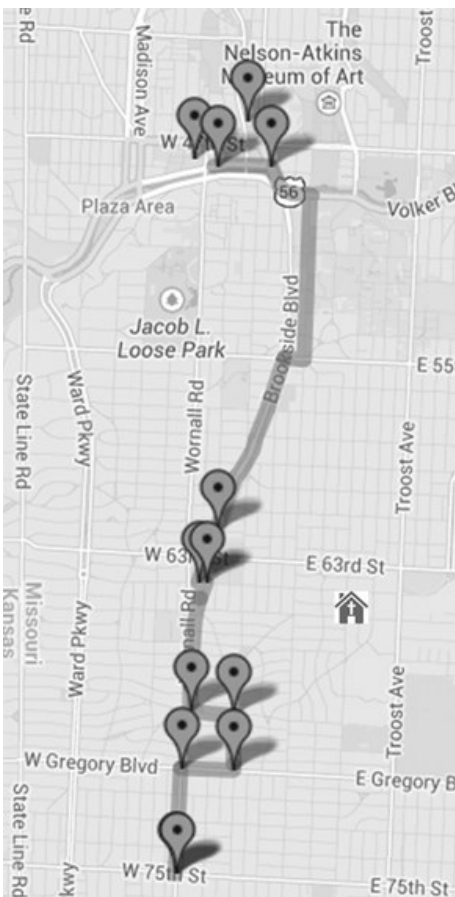

### Trolley Run/Walk for CCVI

Beginning at 7:45 a.m. on Sunday, April 27, the annual Trolley Run and Walk will be taking place. It begins at 75<sup>th</sup> & Wornall and ends on the Plaza at Brookside Boulevard & Ward Parkway. This may affect your ability to get to the morning Masses at St. Peter's, so we wanted to make you aware of the route, so that you can build in extra time and plan your approach, if you are coming to St. Peter's from the west. Basically, the route will involve Wornall Rd., Gregory Blvd., Main St., 69<sup>th</sup> St., Brookside Rd., Meyer Blvd., Brookside Blvd. 55<sup>th</sup> St., Oak St., Volker Blvd., Brookside Blvd., to Ward Parkway. 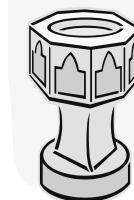
