#### Dietrich Bonhoeffer: Meditation and Prayer edited by Peter Frick

Dietrich Bonhoeffer was a German Lutheran pastor executed by the Nazis on April 9, 1945 (less than one month before the Nazis surrendered to the Allies). He is remembered throughout the Christian community for his preaching and writing, most particularly his magnum opus *The Cost of Discipleship* and his concept of *cheap grace*. Discipleship comes at a steep price and so does grace. In many ways Pope Francis' themes of evangelization and mercy resound with Bonhoeffer's perception of the role and obligations of each and every Christian.

The editor of this book remarks that "Every Christian needs spiritual direction." And that is certainly true. However, there is an chronic shortage of qualified spiritual directors. Books like this help fill the gap and, when combined with use in a small group of open and committed believers, bring us close to critical insight and accountability that individual spiritual direction can give.

There is no substitute for a good spiritual director. Pastor Bonhoeffer was certainly much more than a spiritual director. But this book can help guide the seeker in the ways of our Savior.

### Reporting Abuse

2. Contact your local law enforcement agency or 911

After reporting to civil authorities, report suspected *sexual abuse of a minor* or vulnerable adult to the Diocesan Ombudsman, Jenifer Valenti, at (816) 812-2500 or e-mail at [JeniferValenti@att.net](mailto:JeniferValenti@att.net), if the abuse involves a priest or deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.
