Invitation to the Psalms:

A Readers Guide for Discovery and Engagement

by Rolf Jacobson and Karl Jacobson



The Book of Psalms ought to be the most cherished book in the Old Testament, if not in the whole of Scripture. The 150 songs it contains run the gamut of human emotions from praise and thanksgiving to pleading, cursing and, the most common type of psalm, the lament. The majority were also composed originally for liturgical worship. In all cases they reflect dialog with God and, in their own special way, grant us "permission" to share those emotions with God in very direct and personal language.

The authors, teachers both, take the serious student (which we all ought to be) on an engaging tour of Hebrew poetry in general and the Psalms in particular. We learn how the different types of psalms are constructed and what that structure can tell us about the context and meaning of these prayers. The symbols and metaphors within the psalms are explained for us and this permits us to dig ever deeper into these most beautiful of scriptural prayers.

This book is clear, concise and accessible. It is available for Kindle as well as in paperback new and used.

Reporting Abuse

The Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph is committed to combatting sexual abuse in the Church. If you are the victim of sexual abuse or if you *suspect* sexual abuse:

2. Contact your local law enforcement agency or 911

After reporting to civil authorities, report suspected *sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult* to the Diocesan Ombudsman, Jenifer Valenti, at (816) 812-2500 or e-mail at JeniferValenti@att.net, if the abuse involves a priest or deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.
