As our St. Peter's school year begins, we think also of our recent graduates who are beginning their high school careers. . If you weren't involved in the graduation festivities last May, you may not have heard about all the great accomplishments of our STP Class of 2012. So, here's a little piece from the "Class of 2012 Report Card" that Janet Spallo shared with graduates and their families:

- Number of service hours performed by the Class of 2012 = 1086
- Number of scholarships awarded = 32
- Number of students receiving scholarships = 21
- Number of students qualifying of the Duke University Talent Identification Program (TIP) = 34 (62% of the class)
- 7 students scored 99 on the HSPT (High School Placement Test)
- Class composite percentile rank on 2012 Iowa Test of Basic Skills = 98
- 12 students earned Class Honors/Final Grade (straight As)
- 13 students earned First Honors/Final Grade (all As, 1 B)

We are proud of all our students, but take special pride in this class, and all their accomplishments. We wish them all great luck
