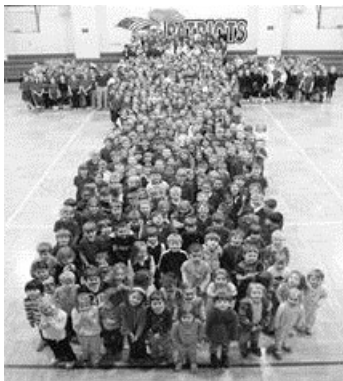
### Christ Renews His Parish (CRHP) Registration for the Fall

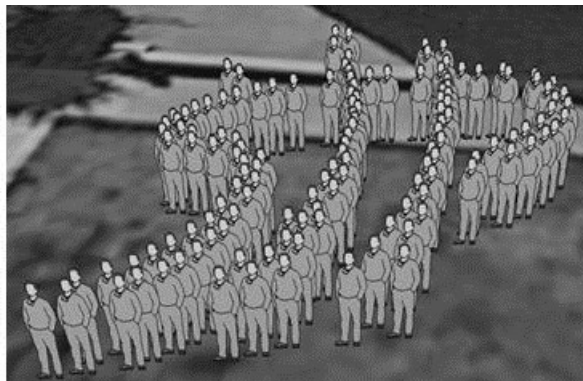
### STP Spirit Day
