Finance Update

The 2011/2012 Fiscal Year budget came to a close on 06/30/2012. St. Peter's received 98% of its budgeted amount for Collections this past fiscal year. The shortfall was equal to approximately one week of the budgeted amount of \$48,673.00.

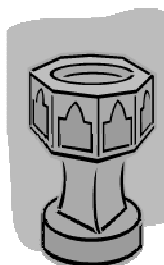
