Dear St. Peter's Parishioners,

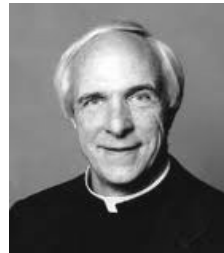

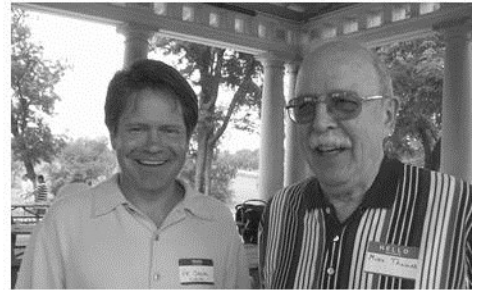
