Our Lady of Fatima Statue is Coming to St. Peter's

This "pilgrim" statue is one of only a handful of replicas of the original statue modeled after Our Lady as she appeared to three shepherd children in 1913 and is designated to travel throughout the United States. It was blessed by Pope Paul VI in 1967 and along with it comes the Blessed Mother's message at Fatima, which is simply one of mercy and prayer. The ultimate purpose of this devotion is to lead us to greater love of Jesus. Mr. Bill Sockey will accompany the statue will speak on Our Lady's message and how it is relevant to our lives today. On June 18, the statue will be on display from before Mass at 8:15a.m. until 7 p.m. which corresponds with Eucharistic Adoration that Tuesday. At that point Mr. Sockey will talk about Fatima.
