



St. Peter's School Class of 2016 Report Card

- Number of Service Hours Performed by the Class of 2016 = 1,424
- Several classmates were honored at the KC Science and Engineering Fair by receiving awards above and beyond the Grand Awards of Gold and Silver!
- There were 22 scholarships awarded among 15 students from the class (21% of the class).
- Scholarship funds received total \$17,450.
- The number of students who qualified for the Duke University Talent Identification Program = 40 (55% of the class).
 - Three classmates who took either the ACT or SAT as seventh graders earned State Recognition, and one earned Grand Recognition (Duke TIP).
- HSPT Scores
 - 13 students scored between 96-99 (18% of the class)
 - 4 more earned between 90 and 95 (17%)
 - Therefore, 35% of the Class of 2016 scored between 90 and 99 percentile on HSPT.
 - Another 25% scored between 80-89% percentile
- Class of 2016 Composite Percentile Rank on the 2015 ITBS = 98.
- An outstanding 97% of the Class of 2016 earned Final Honor Roll status:
 - 14 (19%) earned Class Honors (all As)
 - 38 (52%) earned First Honors, which is a GPA of 3.5-3.9
 - 19 (26%) earned Second Honors
- Put on the fabulous and fun performance of *SHREK, Jr.* in May 2016
- Served as School Family Leaders
