All students are to be picked up near the school office in the cafeteria at Southwest or in the main room of the Legacy Center at the conclusion of enrichment classes with the exception of those who are to be sent to ASC. Some instructors offer a snack after school as part of the fee; if your child has any food allergies, please let the instructor or Mrs. Meyer know.

Drama/Musical Theatre—Mrs. Pam Sollars and Ms. Val Fagan, Instructors

Need a little less drama in life and more drama on stage where it belongs? Students can join school parent and actor, Pam Sollars, along with Broadway veteran Val Fagan, in a fun-filled semester of acting and creative dramatics. Through theatre games and exercises, students will develop the tools and confidence needed to perform in front of live audiences. A performance of a mini-musical will be presented at the end of the session. (This semester we will parody the popular musical High School Musical and make it "St. Peter's centered" with a fun twist. It will be called appropriately 8th Grade Musical. Spoof will contain fun and positive elements experienced last year in Lion King, including an over-the-top drama teacher named Mrs. Fran Buoyant.) This class/performance is open to students in grades 1-8 and includes 10 classes plus the performance. After-school snacks and treats included.

This semester Homework Club will be on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Students can participate once per week, or both days. Each 45-minute session offers students the opportunity to receive some assistance in a supervised setting and will be particularly helpful for students who struggle with organization and/or have difficulty focusing on assignments. Homework Club is for students in grades 3-8.

Weather permitting, we will be out on the track and field during our sessions. This is a six-week course intended for students in grades 1-3. A small snack will be provided.
