Dear Women of St. Peters,

As a woman of any age, there are many calls that beckon for our attention. Becoming an active member of the Women of St. Peters does not need to be a large commitment, but a chance for you to lend your hands to a number of important ministries in our church. Most of the opportunities only require service once or twice a year, but have a significant impact on the sacraments we share (baptismal garments and purificators for Holy Communion) as well as impact our prayer life and community gathering spaces (replacing the candles that embody our prayerful petitions and cleaning the church).

We ask for \$10 in annual dues to support our ministries annual – collected in September. These dues cover such expenses as contributions to the church for monthly mass intentions, annual appreciation gifts, and special purchases such as vestments for our priests
