*****If your child tests + for COVID-19, the same 3 underlined criteria listed in yellow needs to be met before returning to school.**

If your child has fever and other symptoms that could be from COVID-19 and does not get tested OR is not cleared by your doctor, it is assumed the child has COVID-19 and may not return to school until the 3 following criteria are met: At least 24 hours have passed since recovery (no fever without the use of medication), AND child has improvement of symptoms, AND at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.

Has your child been fever free without medication for 24 hours? If fever-free for 24 hours unmedicated and no other symptoms have developed, your child may return to school.

If no contact with anyone who tested positive for COVID-19, child may return to school. However, if child was in contact with someone who tested + for COVID 19, see 3 underlined criteria in yellow box.
